

February 8, 2018 Meeting Minutes

- President's Report
 - Save School Music Programs:
 - Representative, John, is grandfather of one students and was at the SEC concert
 - His organization educates parent on how to talk to the board and the school district about how important the music programs are
 - Example: 1 teacher to 75 students getting bang for your buck
 - The key is if you have to cut \$2M, if you cut your music dept the student have to go elsewhere for that time, so the district has to hire 2 teachers to cover the students now in other classes.
 - First thing to go normally is 6th grade music lessons
 - Equips parents to speak in a language that the admin can understand
 - Provides both the emotional and factual information to present what gives the most impact
 - Would need to target the younger parents as well for support Jr High parents
 - They analyze the district and puts together a lobbying package to give to parent group
 - \$4000, will discount half of the cost and there is another group who will donate the other half of that, end cost being \$1000 to FLAMB
 - There are also other options for support you don't have to go with full support option
 - Questions:
 - How are you going to get parent involvement?
 - What is the end result?

 - Will they help with parent participation?

 - That would require and administration decision
 - Funds would go to the school's general fund not to the music dept
 - Could ask the admin if we could put out donation buckets
 - Who pays for the Bethel concert?
 - The funds come out of the FLAMB general fund
 - The goal is to break even on costs

 - Could have 3 5 different ideas for logos
 - Could have kids get pre-orders
