Restoring Music Program Discussion:

Introduced Lisa Sauer to get some parent ideas on ways we would like to prioritize fro spending, from a music program perspective.

Lisa led the group, getting parents and people to propose their ideas in the areas of:

- Programming -Top Ideas:
 - Pick an instrument earlier start in 5th Grade
 - More lessons/smaller lesson groups (2 to 3 kids in a 20 minute slot)
 - Evening concerts for elementary
- Staffing Top Ideas:
 - Teachers need reasonable schedules
- Capital funds Top Ideas:
 - Instrument replacement
 - Discrepancies between rental and use for larger instruments (Tuba/Cello/French Horn)

The group wrote their ideas and shared them. The music programs teachers are compiling the ideas.
