Advocacy Committee Report – Laura Livermore, FLAMB President

- Primary focus is on the 'Vote Yes' campaign to get the upcoming levy passed.
 - The group brainstormed ideas on ways to support the effort:
 - Calling Other groups PTOs, Vote Yes, Teachers are doing calling Lots of groups already doing. Decided to focus on supporting other groups calling efforts and getting participation in Lit Drops:
 - Molly Bonnet from Vote Yes, stopped by. She will send the volunteer form to Laura Livermore and Laura will send that out to our email list. She also encouraged all of us to just bring up the Levy and encourage parents to vote.

Outreach Committee Report – Kelly Biedny, FLAMB Secretary

- Primary focus for now will be getting potential gigs, for the music students to perform and get the FLAHS music program visible
