

## March 14, 2019 Meeting Minutes at 6:30 pm

Call to order: 6:35 pm

## Officer/Committee Reports:

- Advocacy Committee & President's Report Laura Livermore, FLAMB President
  - Update on Lobby Day
    - 3/26 10:00am to 3:00pm depends on appts which are being set-up.
    - 1 student signed up
  - o Town Hall, if rescheduled, will try to attend, haven't heard of a reschedule at this time.
- Fundraising Committee Report Rebecca Gibson, FLAMB Fundraising Chair
  - Update on Pizza Cards Laura Livermore, FLAMB President
    - Sold approximately 300 cards
    - Tying up loose ends, vendor letting us send back cards we didn't sell
  - o Candy Bars Laura Livermore, FLAMB President
    - Still ongoing
    - Conversations with Middle School selling them this spring
    - Those selling them are selling well
  - Spring Fundraiser Holly Wojciechowski, FLAMB Vice-President
    - All set for the Mixed Bag Designs fundraiser
      - Will start both online and catalog sales April 1 or 8th, 2019
        - Catalog due April 22 so everything will be delivered by Mother's Day
        - Online goes until End of June
        - Kick-off for fundraiser will be before Spring Break
          - Catalog sales can start right after, but online will NOT be available until April 1 or 8th, 2019
        - Profit is 35%, students will get 30%, if we go over sales threshold, % goes up by 5%
      - Holly Wojciechowski will be point of contact and her name is on materials.
- Outreach Committee & V.P. Report Holly Wojciechowski, FLAMB Vice-President
  - Dueling Pianos Kelly Biedny, FLAMB Secretary -
    - Detailed after event notes are posted on the website.
  - Scholarship Committee Update June Quevedo & Deborah LeGault, FLAMB Scholarship Committee Co-Chairs -
    - Need more committee members
      - Kris Blackburn is joining the committee
      - Holly will post some information on Facebook on who to contact to join the committee
    - Will get together to talk about points system and approve before the scholarship application deadline of April 30, 2019
    - So far just one application received

- Laura Livermore will go through applications and remove all identifying info from apps to provide to selection committee.
- Website Kelly Biedny, FLAMB Secretary -
  - Upgrading site and allowing credit card payments for various things through the site discussed. Looked into current host upgrade (Wix), but we would need the \$20 a month plan and cheaper options are available.
  - Recommend setting up a wordpress site hosted through BlueHost.
    - Hosting is will be about \$7.99 a month (\$2.95 a month the first year)
    - The domain would be up to \$12 a year per domain.
      - o Recommend getting .org, .com, & .net (up to \$12 each).
    - Annual website expense would be about \$108 up to \$132. Although the first year would only be at most \$72
  - Holly Wojciechowski moved to approve \$150, Kris Blackburn seconded, motion approved,
  - Getting Pre-sale tickets for Bethel concert are the first priority for online payment (tickets are \$10)
    - Will charge 3% more when buying with cc to cover fees

## **Old Business:**

- FLAMB Officer Incentives -
  - Put in a lot of time, especially Dave Gunderson (Treasurer) and Laura Livermore (President), propose this year
    - Full Trip Compensation for Pres and Treasurer
    - Half Trip Compensation for VP, Secretary, Fundraising
  - This Year
    - Outgoing VP will receive \$350 for her years of service.
  - For new officers will ask for a 2 year commitment
    - If term is less than 2 years, comp will be prorated.
  - Kris Blackburn moved this Officer Incentive plan, Michelle Chanak seconded, motion was approved.
- Tri-M John Gorka Concert -
  - Have sold 20 tickets, need to sell 70 to break even
  - o Cost is \$1300
  - Will sell rootbeer floats there
    - Tri-M kids will fully staff rootbeer floats and concert
    - Michelle Chanak will make sure we have supplies
    - Dave Livermore will get Tri-M kids signed up for staffing
- Bethel Concert April 26
  - We are all good on Adult volunteers
    - Water sales 2 people are needed and we have
    - Ticket sales 2 people are needed and we have
  - Holly Wojciechowski will lead the flower sales and contact Carrie Carlson. Kelly Biedny will assist.
  - Ushers -
    - We need kids for this
      - Michelle will get link to sign-up genius to Dave Livermore and he will send to kids to get more usher
  - o Buses for middle schoolers for concert -
    - Cost \$300 each

- Holly moved to do 2 buses for no charge to students, seconded by Kris Blackburn, motion approved.
- o NYC 2020 Trip Updates -
  - Dave Livermore confirmed we are definitely going to New York and will get updated info out this week.
  - For the flight we may be chartering a plane, which would affect the dates (Wednesday to Sunday week of Spring Break instead of Saturday to Wednesday). Will confirm asap.
  - 175 are signed up so far (140 students, 35 chaperones).
- Root beer Float Updates Michelle Chanak -
  - Over all is going well
  - Need to have minimum of two people, but for elementary evening concerts have minimum of three needed.
  - Discussion on limiting the number of times people can sign up to allow more families to participate was discussed.
    - Limit number of times to 2 concerts
  - Will have back-ups list for no shows that Michelle can call last minute if needed.
    - Contact Michelle to get on the list
  - Will adding the following info to confirmation and reminders that are generated through sign-up genius
    - A note to contact Michelle if you can't make it because there are others that would like to fill in.
    - How to get on alternate list to fill in for no shows or someone can't make it.
