Officer/Committee Reports:

Advocacy Committee & President's Report - Laura Livermore, FLAMB President

- Update on Lobby Day
 - Two teachers and two students met with our state legislators on March 26 to discuss adequately and equitably funding our schools and how that would affect FLAS music programs, met with all local except Dettmer as he was unavailable.
 - FLAMB families need to continue to put pressure on our legislature to step up and fund the schools so we can restore FLAS music programs.

 - Volunteers should arrive at 6:30
 - Holly, Lois, Kelly doing flowers
 - Michelle will bring water
 - 2 cases of water
 - Cash boxes (3)
 - Ticket Signage Laura will get them printed.
 - Non-school age free
 - Seniors who ask get senior discount
 - We'll count money during Jazz Band after concert
 - We are not doing physical tickets
 - Those with Forest Lake Staff IDs get one comp ticket, not spouses or guests
 - Michelle will have it advertised on Kool 108
 - No Buses for kids even though we would fund because we have no staffing available for buses.
- NYC 2020 Trip updates -- students requesting refunds
 - 164 people signed up
 - Some people have asked for refunds. Deposits are non-refundable. At this point we are giving additional payment refunds, but once we've paid for trip expenses no refunds will be provided (After May 1st)
