- How do we want to proceed.
 - Should we continue with butter braids 40%, Other things are: Coffee 40%, Chocolate 50% (FLAMB takes 5%, kids get the rest in their account)
 - Will do Butter Braids & Coffee Sell through November 15 possibly Katrina will call to see deadlines and delivery timelines.
- Do we want to do grocery bagging?
 - Made \$1100 last year, great for outreach. Need about 12 to 15 kids per shift Debbie LeGualt will coordinate...will call and get info to Laura, June and Kelly on dates and sign-up
- Dairy Queen/Culvers 10% for the evening, need parent and child parent participation can do it only once a month. About 2 kids and parents per shift (1.5 hour total for a total of 3 hour shift) will probably back burner until after the New York Trip to get other kids excited about the NEXT trip.
