Spring Spectacular Concert at Benson Great Hall (Bethel) - recap

- Bethel Expenses: \$3778.00 includes 142 dinners at dining all, Great Hall and additional spaces rental including tech, ushers and custodial
 - Katrina purchased gift cards for each of the music directors (3 HS and 1 student teacher)
 - 100 roses ordered from Costco and mini flower stem vases from Amazon
 - Will sell for \$5.00 each both pre-sale and at the door.
- Ticket Sales:
 - Total online sales before fees: \$2383 for tickets and \$235 for roses.
 - Total sales at event (tickets and roses): \$1970 in cash box including checks
 - Tickets collected:

- Funds that are donated - There were mixed opinions on how to handle funds that are donated directly to the website. There was an individual donation to one of the elementary schools. For this year, that teacher will receive 100% of the donation. Will need further discussion.
- T-Shirts - All 6th grade t-shirts from the second sale were delivered to the students prior to the concerts.
- Scholarship - June Quevedo provided update that winners were selected and she would plan to attend FLAHS awards banquet with Katrina Bastyr
- Root Beer Floats - FLAMB Boosters have been serving root beer floats for the May concerts. Important to get Tri-M volunteers for next year in May if possible. Have had good sales, one FLAMB officer has made an announcement prior to each concert talking about FLAMB and noting that all profits from root beer float sales and donations go back to the respective music group performing.

Since delay in completing meeting minutes from May here is a recap of sales from June 5th, 2022 Email:

- Root beer float costs are currently 50% of the sale price of \$2.00 (\$1.00), 95% of profits go back to the ensemble group and 5% to the general fund.

Cash Donations - \$101.00, Root Beer Float Sales - \$97.00 (\$46.08 to middle school choir)
 - **5/24/22 Elementary Orchestra (Schreiber) - Total Proceeds: \$144.30**
Cash Donations - \$74.00, Root Beer Float Sales - \$148.00 (\$70.30 to orchestra)
 - **6/1/22 9th Grade Band/Orchestra - Total Proceeds: \$184.13**
Cash Donations - \$120.00, Root Beer Float Sales - \$135.00 (\$64.13 to high school account)
- Pops Concert - Scholarships will be announced during the concert, Katrina will order carnations for seniors and music directors. Many candy bars left over - will sell at Pops Concert for \$1 each
